- 4 boxes - regular thickness Crayola crayons

- *scissors

Please use your discretion on how much you want to spend but please don't purchase the Dollar Store brand - they don't last and one other thing we have learned - please do not buy ear buds - they need headphones. A \$5.00 - \$10.00 pair would be sufficient. If you cannot afford this your child will still be able to use some of the school's headphones that are shared with other students throughout the year.

The rest of the supplies will be used and shared by the classroom.

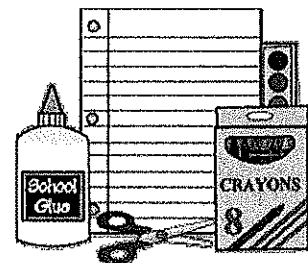

Third Grade Supply List

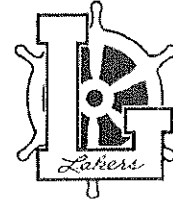
Here are suggestions for your back-to-school shopping. With the great "Back to School" sales, it is a good idea to stock up and keep extra supplies at home.

1. (1) pkg of wide-ruled notebook paper (150 ct.)
2. Number 2 pencils. (Students can use up to 2 dozen per month.)
3. Small pencil box or pouch.
4. Pencil top erasers
5. (2) boxes crayons (24 ct)
6. (2) pkgs. Colored pencils
7. (2) pkgs. Markers (1 thin and 1 broad)
8. (1) small bottle of glue
9. (3) small glue sticks
10. 1 pr. Scissors
11. (2) 2-pocket folders (large laminated kind - no prongs)
12. (3) 4-ct. dry erase markers (Asst., broad-tip, low odor)
13. (4) composition (wide ruled) notebooks (no wire, please)
14. (2) large boxes of tissue (Extras are welcome!)
15. 1 backpack (no wheels)
16. (1) large container of disinfecting wipes
17. Earbuds/headphones placed in a Ziploc bag labeled with name

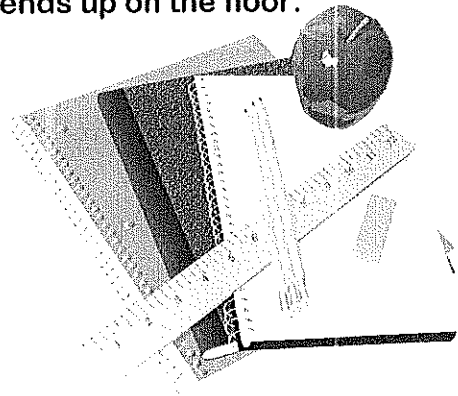
Welcome Future Fourth Graders!



Here are a few suggestions for back-to-school shopping for the fourth grade. There are many back-to-school sales during the summer, so we hope this list will help you prepare for next year.

- **Notebook Paper**
 - 4-5 packages of wide rule paper
- **Pencils and Erasers**
 - The regular style pencil is best. Pencils with refillable lead tend to be distracting and often the lead ends up on the floor.
- **Crayons/Markers/Colored Pencils**
 - Any of the three would be fine.
- **Colored Pen**
- **2 Glue Sticks**
- **2 Highlighters (keep one at home)**
- **Scissors**
- **Small Pencil Pouch for Binder (Optional)**
- **Back Pack**
- **2-4 Dry Erase Markers**

(You may want to buy extras to keep at home. These have the tendency to get lost throughout the year and students need to supply their own markers.)
- **Tissues (2 boxes)**
- **5 – 2 Pocket plastic folders (Try to find a yellow, blue and red folder to match the spiral notebooks. The color of the fourth folder is your choice. Try to find folders that are 3-hole punched.)**
- **4 – 1 Subject spiral bound notebooks (Try to find a blue and a red notebook if possible. The other colors are your choice.)**
- **Trapper Keeper or other organizational binder (This will hold the folders and notebooks while changing classes.)**
